- **Bright Stars**
- **Medium Bright Stars**

Scan the sky with binoculars: the darker the sky, the better.

- **Open Star Clusters:**
 M-44 - The Beehive
 M-45 - The Pleiades
 "Double Cluster" between Perseus and Cassiopeias
 The Hyades form the face of Taurus
- **A Spiral Galaxy:**
 M-31 in Andromeda
- **A Nebula:**
 M-42 - the Orion Nebula
